This week will be another active one! Please read the important information below.

3. Our Canvas Conference **ENGLISH I-Honors 5th Block WEDNESDAY, NOV 18TH @1:15PM**

During this week's conference we will discuss *informational text* reading assignments and the corresponding Study Island sessions for this week. This information is part of the foundational content of the English I course. Although it may be difficult for some students, they will be able to retake any of these sessions to achieve a higher score-(80% or higher will be recorded as a 100 classwork grade). Some students may need to complete these 10 question sessions a couple of times, but this repetition will aid in retention of the content material. Please be sure to read the explanations if the answer choice is incorrect, as the questions may be repeated. I encourage all students to attend and participate in this live instruction as there will be an opportunity to **EARN BONUS POINTS WHEN YOU ACTIVELY PARTICIPATE.**

4. Be sure to log into your school email and Canvas each day. You should work on Block classes Mon-Wed-Fri and work on Period classes Tues-Thurs, but you **MUST COMPLETE THE DAILY ATTENDANCE ASSIGNMENT EACH DAY.** Using a calendar will help you stay on track, and this is the best way to avoid **MISSING ASSIGNMENTS!** **For Term 2 students will not be able to turn in assignments after the weekly 11:59pm Sunday deadline unless they have an excused absence.**
